Warranty

GENERAL BARBECUE WARRANTY CONDITIONS

The warranty applies to the original purchaser from the date of purchase and covers manufacturing faults and defects only. If an item should fail as a result of a manufacturing fault or defect under normal domestic use, the manufacturer at their discretion will repair, refinish or replace the failed item.

The manufacturer reserves the right to substitute failed items with a similar product should the model or colour no longer be available. Any replacement will be for the failed item only, where compatible parts are available, not a complete barbecue. The original warranty period is not extended in the event of a repair, refinish or replacement.

In the event of failure, it is the customer's responsibility to return the item to the store of purchase along with a copy of the original receipt. Leisuregrow will confirm that we have a completed warranty card from the customer completed at time of purchase and returned to Leisuregrow for Warranty to have been registered.

Warranty specifically excludes general wear and tear, rusting of steel components and parts, natural weathering of timber parts, metal corrosion, commercial use and damage caused as a result of failure to observe reasonable care, maintenance and assembly instructions for both barbecue and hardware.

- LP/Propane Gas Cylinder. The cylinder manufacturer is responsible for the materials, workmanship and performance of the gas cylinder. Contact your dealer or the cylinder manufacturer in respect of all warranty claims or service.

BARBECUE AFTER-CARE

Use a brass bristle wire cleaning brush after use to clean your barbecue. For best results follow this by leaving all burners on high for 5 – 10 minutes. Turn the burners off, and when the barbecue has cooled down, wipe over with a damp cloth and coat with cooking oil to help protect cooking surfaces against rust. Always use a barbecue mitt when cleaning to avoid burning yourself.

NOT COVERED

Storage

Exposure of the barbecue appliance to the elements should be minimised. Once the unit has cooled and is cleaned, store the barbecue under cover. Polyester/vinyl barbecue covers are an optional accessory that will ensure years of trouble free operation.

This warranty does not cover the purchaser or any other person for damage, malfunction or loss due to the following:

- Lack of maintenance, abuse, neglect, misuse, accident or improper installation of this appliance.
- Scratches, dents, corrosion or discolouring caused by heat, abrasive or chemical cleaners or chipping on porcelain parts.
- Corrosion or damage caused by exposure to the elements, grease fires, insects, weather or hail.
- Cleaning and normal wear and tear.

Note: Barbecues must be covered when not in use.

- Rusting of cast iron plates, grills and burners.
- Commercial use of the barbecue.

Unauthorised repairs during the warranty period.

- Removal or re-installation costs.
- Cracks and weathering of timber parts caused by exposure to the elements or damage by weather, heat, insects, chemicals or foods acids or juices.

PLEASE NOTE

You do not need to register for the Standard warranty. Registering your warranty will automatically upgrade the warranty from Standard to Extended. However, you must retain your receipt or proof of purchase. When claiming warranty for this appliance you must provide a copy of your proof of purchase receipt. No claims for warranty will be accepted without proof of purchase.

CONDITIONS OF WARRANTY

1. The appliance is delivered to Leisuregrow distributor's service department or authorised service agent and freight charges both ways are paid by the owner. No liability is accepted for loss or damage during transit.
2. The appliance is installed by a qualified person and operated and maintained in accordance with the instructions supplied. Repairs or service must be carried out by an authorised person.
3. Installation must conform to the applicable Gas, Electrical and Building standards laid down by the local codes for your country or region.
4. No alterations or repairs have been carried out without obtaining the distributors prior consent. Such repair or any replacement does not extend the warranty period.
5. Proof of purchase together with the warranty card must be provided to verify purchase date and establish the warranty period. Only the original purchaser is covered under this warranty.
6. The warranty period is calculated from the date of purchase only.
7. Where this warranty is inconsistent with any state laws, the statutory rights of the purchaser shall prevail.
8. Parts installed from other manufacturers' products will void this warranty.
